

TERMS & CONDITIONS

Alteration to Itinerary - Great Australian Bight Safaris reserves the right to change, modify or cancel any tour due to adverse road or weather conditions or other unforeseen circumstances which may in the opinion of the operator affect passenger safety and comfort. Any personal expense incurred by such change is the responsibility of the passenger

Deposit & payment - Payment will be accepted in cash (AUD) traveller's cheques, or bank certified cheque. For all tours a deposit of 10% per head is required to confirm your booking. The balance is payable in full 14 days before departure. For all day and half day tours, advance bookings are confirmed on payment of a deposit equal to 20% of the fare.

All fares must be paid in full prior to departure of the tour.

Cancellation - For all tours, cancellations notified more than 28 days prior to departure will be entitled to a full refund. Cancellations notified less than 28 days but more than 14 days prior to departure will forfeit the full deposit Cancellations notified less than 14 days prior to departure will be debited the full fare.

GAWLER RANGES FOR A DAY



Visit The Gawler Ranges for a Day
from Port Lincoln

Eyre Peninsula is recognised as an area where the sea and Outback meet. You can now take the opportunity to visit an area many have heard of, but have not been able to visit, the remote wonder of the Gawler Ranges.

This tour departs from Port Lincoln at 7.30 am, with you being picked up from your accommodation.

Then travel via Central Eyre Peninsula to Wudinna and enter the Gawler Ranges National Park via Mount Sturt. (Fire Ban Days via Main Entrance).

Visit the Old Paney Homestead and Policeman's Point.

Travel the Mattera, LP & Conical Hill Tracks, visiting the Old Pondanna farm.

Visit the spectacular Yandinga Gorge and then on to the Organ Pipes, both



of which have significant Rhyolite formations. In other locations these could also be called a Giants Causeway.

You will then return via Minnipa to Port Lincoln.

This is a long day and you will not be home until 8pm. We will cover over 600kms, however if you are short on time and want to see this area, here is an excellent opportunity to travel with experienced guides who can take you to some of the best, there is to see, in



the Gawler Ranges.

An abundance of wildlife, with emus, kangaroo's, both grey and red, euros (Wallaroo's) and perhaps even a yellow footed rock wallaby, high among the hills.

Other creatures to observe include the Pink Cockatoo (Major Mitchell) regularly seen feeding on the ground, or catch a glimpse as the numerous, Port Lincoln & Mulga Parrots fly from roost to roost among the mallee & black oak woodlands.

Follow the history of both the exploration of this area, and see in a day, what would have taken weeks to accom-

plish 150 years ago.

Learn about Eyre, Darke, Warburton & Hack as they explored this region. Follow the early pastoral enterprises and the tales of tragedy and disasters that were commonplace.

Today, with the creation of the Gawler Ranges National Park, there are many new things being learned about how fragile this harsh land really is.
